### Answers:

1. (a) True. Even though there are no formal relations between Israel and Qatar, thousands of Israelis traveled to Qatar to be at the World Cup soccer competition. .
2. (a) There was at least one direct flight from Israel to Qatar carrying Israeli and Palestinian fans. However, there will not be any public kosher stands/establishments at the World Cup.

4. (a) The party asked to form the coalition can request an extension of 14 days in order to finish negotiations with the minor parties.

6. (d) Zion Mule Corp was a military organization organized during World War I that fought alongside the British. Joseph Trumpeldor was born on November 21, 1880, was drafted to the Russian army in 1902, made aliyah in 1912 and was killed in 1919.
7. (b) Anwar Sadat flew to Israel to pursue peace and addressed a special session of the Knesset. This was the first visit of an Arab leader to the Jewish State.
8. (a) This is attributed to Joseph Trumpeldor who was killed while defending the northern settlement of Tel Chai. Joseph Trumpeldor was drafted into the Czar's army while he was still in Russia and was an ardent Zionist who helped establish the first defense organizations in Palestine.
