Food for Thought @ Your Shabbat Table: Should the Knesset consider MK Strock's proposal?

## Answers:

- 1. (b) MK Benny Gantz was a student of Rabbi Druckman a"H at his Yeshivat Or Etzion. Rabbi Druckman was one of the founders of the settler movement. He attended a Pesah seder in Hebron in 1968 which spearheaded the re-establishment of a Jewish community in Hebron.
- 2. (a) Rabbi Druckman a"H was the leader of the National Religious Party, Mafdal, for many years. He left to form his own party, but then returned to NRP shortly after. He was a religious mentor to many in the NRP political camp.
- 3. (a) True. Rabbi Druckman a"H believed that Jews have the right to settle the land and the IDF should not participate in evicting them from their settlements. He stopped short of telling them to disobey orders. Rabbi Druckman a"H had moved to Yamit in 1982 when the Israeli government dismantled that settlement in accordance with the Camp David Peace Accords.
- 4. (c) Oman's lower house of parliament voted to expand all forms of boycott of Israel, including the possibility of overhead flights. Overhead flights is one of the initiatives that Netanyah was set to attempt again as he regained the office of PM.
- 5. (c) MK Orit Strock proposed that doctors should be able to refuse to perform a particular treatment for a patient if it violates their religious beliefs and there is a doctor nearby who could perform the treatment at a similar price.
- 6. (b) Israel's Christian population has increased by 2% in 2021, bringing the total number of Christians living in Israel to 185,000. Most Christian communities are located in Northern Israel.
- 7. (c) Keren HaYesod was founded on December 24, 1920, to aid the World Zionist Organization in bringing Jews to Israel and supporting their aliyah. Keren HaYesod did much to support infrastructure in the country in the 20s and 30s. Today it still aids aliyah and poorer communities in Israel.
- 8. (a) Rabbi Druckamn a"H said this in a recent interview. He was a firm believer in settling the land and supported those who did.
