Answers:

4. (a) Neve Yaakov is located North of the Old City, close to Bet Haninah.

5. (a) Neve Yaakov was first established in 1924. Its Jewish residents purchased land from the residents of Bet Haninah. The Jewish community of Neve Yaakov left, when Jordan won that part of Jerusalem in the 1948 war. The neighborhood was reestablished after the Israelis reunited the city in 1967.

6. (b) False, Neve Yaakov is a mixed neighborhood that has a Haredi population, Ethiopian and Russian olim.

7. (a) Security forces have increased their presence in Haredi neighborhoods of Jerusalem, as they were the scenes of two shooting attacks over Shabbat.

8. (d) Yitzhak Rabin said this during the violence that Israel experienced in the aftermath of the signing of the Declaration of Principles in 1993. With suicide bombings happening often, in the aftermath of agreements with the Palestinians, he sought to encourage the Israeli people to pursue continued negotiations with the Palestinian Authority.
